A total of 130 garments and accessories that tell her story will be auctioned from February 28 to March 10 on the Drouot platform.

An iconic international figure of Parisian chic, Anouk Aimée embodies a singular femininity—infused with mystery and sensual grace—that has inspired legendary filmmakers such as Federico Fellini, Jacques Demy, and Bernardo Bertolucci, all captivated by her magnetism and unique on-screen aura.

From the 1960s onward, under the influence of her friend Coco Chanel, she became the symbol of a refined, understated style—an aesthetic that mirrored her acting: introspective, minimalist, yet infinitely expressive.

This style reached its pinnacle in *Un Homme et une Femme* (1966) by Claude Lelouch, where her enigmatic presence and profoundly captivating gaze mesmerized both the screen and audiences worldwide.

William Klein (1926-2022) was a major figure of the 20th century, leaving an indelible mark as a photographer, painter, filmmaker, and graphic designer. His influence spans across various artistic disciplines, notably revolutionizing fashion and street photography. His work on major global metropolises, such as New York (1956), Rome (1959), Moscow (1964), Tokyo (1964), and Paris (2002), earned him international fame, making him one of the most illustrious photographers of his generation.

Many prestigious institutions have dedicated significant retrospectives to him, including the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA) in 1980, the Centre Pompidou in Paris in 2005, Tate Modern in London in 2012, the International Center of Photography in New York in 2022, and the Hanmi Museum in Seoul in 2023, showcasing his photographs, painted contacts, paintings, and excerpts from his films.

Under his guidance and in tribute to his work, the Academy of Fine Arts established the Académie des Beaux-Arts Photography Prize – William Klein in 2019. His artistic legacy endures, continuing to influence younger generations and inspire the world of creation in general.
